

Bali to Implement Tourist Tax to Foreign Tourists from 14 February 2024

Dear Valued Agency Partners,

Effective 14 February 2024, a Tourist Tax will be levied to non-Indonesia passport holders (foreign tourists) who travel to Bali via air, sea and land.

Indonesian passport holders would **not** have to pay the fee when entering Bali from domestic or international.

Payment Method

Please note that the levy of IDR 150,000 can be paid electronically via this link prior to the flight.

- Payment method to use Credit Cards, bank transfer, virtual account, and QRIS.
- Payment can also be made during the trip via Love Bali Endpoints (hotels, travel agents, tourist attractions) that have been registered in the Love Bali system.
- Proof of payment in the form of Levy voucher with a QR code will be sent via email.

Exemption Criteria

Pax under the following categories may apply for an exemption <u>at least 5 days prior</u> to their arrival. Note that the exemption request can also be made via this link.

- Diplomatic and official visa holders;
- · Crew on transportation vehicles;
- Holders of Temporary Stay Permit Card (KITAS) or Permanent Stay Permit Card (KITAP);
- Family unification visa holders;
- · Student visa holders;
- · Golden visa holders;
- And holders of other types of visas.

Foreign tourists who do not pay the levy will be subjected to administrative sanctions. To reduce congestion at the airport, we encourage our trade partners to inform your passengers to pay the levy before arriving in Bali.
